



Greetings from Meridian Homecourt, Updated August 31, 2020

We are looking forward to the fall season. As the weather changes and you transition back to Meridian Homecourt for pickleball play, we are asking patrons to reserve a play period timeslot to ensure our facility adheres to the current health order. This process will go into effect Monday, October 5.

Pickleball play for this fall will be organized as follows: **(Please Note: This process will remain in effect as long as the health order remains in order.**

- Open pickleball play will take place Monday – Friday 7:00am – 3:30pm
- Three play period timeslots each day: 7:00am – 9:30am, 10:00am – 12:30pm and 1:00pm – 3:30pm. 28 individuals will be allowed to play within each play period timeslot.

Process to register for one of the above mentioned play period timeslots as follows:

- Call 208-288-4400 to register for a play period timeslot.
- No monies will be exchanged to register for a play period timeslot.
- Registration for play period timeslots must be made no less than 24 hours in advance.
- Patrons entering the facility will pay day rate or use membership card for admittance into the facility.
- Patrons will not be allowed to register for others and/or a group of individuals.

In an effort to comply with the health order and the gathering of 50 individuals, no more than 28 individuals will be allowed in the pickleball court area during each play period timeslot.

- Two pickleball courts will be set up on Courts 2, 3 and 4.
- 6 nets total

Ladder leagues will not take place during this process. Ladder leagues will be allowed to start again as the gathering of 50 individuals order is lifted. It is our goal for people of all abilities a fair and equitable opportunity to play pickleball and socialize.

Meridian Homecourt is asking for adherence and respect to the following:

- One play period timeslot per day per player is allowed. If space allows, play period timeslots may be obtained day of.
- Registrations can only be made 24 hours in advance.
- Please leave the facility in a timely manner at the conclusion of your play period timeslot. This will allow for Meridian Homecourt staff to clean and disinfect the pickleball area before the next group of players arrive.
- If a match is in process, the match is over at the end of the period play timeslot.
- Clocks located on Court 2, 3 and 4 will serve as official timekeepers.

Thank you for your patience and understanding as Meridian Homecourt takes into consideration other user groups and programs that use the facility as we take the necessary steps to adhere to the public health order while keeping our patrons and staff safe and healthy.
